Quilt Show Rules & Entry Form

Please Read Carefully

1. Entrants must be members of the Forsyth Piecers and Quilters Guild as of the January 2012 membership meeting.
2. Entry must be pieced and constructed by a Forsyth Piecers & Quilters guild member. Wholecloth entries must be constructed by a Forsyth Piecers & Quilters guild member.
3. Each entered item must have its own entry form.
4. Entries cannot have been entered in a previous Forsyth Piecers and Quilters Guild quilt show.
5. Entry must have been completed within the previous five (5) years.
6. Items must be quilted items (i.e. no knitted, crocheted or other crafts will be accepted)
7. The show committee and/or judges reserve the right to divide or combine categories and to move entries to a more appropriate category.
8. Prioritize multiple entries in the event that more entries are received than can be displayed.
9. Entries must be completed and clean.
10. All bed quilts and wall quilts must have a four inch hanging sleeve securely attached.
11. Entries must have a label on the back lower left corner with the quilt name, maker name, and year completed. Cover the label with a separate piece of muslin.
12. Entry forms must be received no later than **February 17, 2012**.
13. To enter, please mail your completed entry form and a photograph of the quilt.

12. Quilts must be received no later than **noon on March 13, 2012**.
13. Quilts may be dropped off at Forsyth Piecers and Quilters guild meetings (February and March meetings) or at Sew Original on Robinhood Road during normal business hours.
13. Quilts may also be dropped off at Lisa Alley's house on Sunday, March 11 between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. (from I-40 Business, take Knollwood Road exit. Go south on Knollwood toward Stratford Rd. Cross Stratford Road and After the light at Queen Street, take the 3rd right onto Maplewood. 2749 is the 9th house on the right—the small white house just past the big brown house.)
14. Each quilt must be placed in a pillow case with the name of the quilt, entrant name, and phone number clearly labeled on the outside of the pillowcase.
15. All quilts must be picked up on **Sunday, March 18, 2012 between 4:30 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. at Village Inn**.
16. Entries will not be returned by mail.
17. You must present the entry claim card in order to claim a quilt.
